At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School at 8:30 and 10:30 am. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and may be picked up in KID Street Headquarters downstairs after worship. There is no Sunday School for youth in grades 6-8 through the summer. The nursery, for infants and toddlers (through age 3), is available at both services, and these children may be dropped off downstairs in the KID Street Headquarters before worship begins. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

In an effort to reduce our trash and spend less money on disposable cups, we invite our regular attenders to bring their own coffee tumbler on Sunday mornings.

Our Second Mile Offering in June and July supports Iglesia Piedra Viva. Volunteers are needed on Friday, July 19 starting at 1:45 pm to pack and distribute bags of groceries.
